

Our confession of faith (excerpt): We believe ...

- In one God, eternally existing in three persons -the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit,
- In the divine inspiration of the Scriptures (the Bible) as the Word of God.
- In Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior, only Son of God manifested in the flesh, crucified, dead, risen, raised to the Father.
- By his death on the cross, everyone who accepts Jesus by faith as Lord and Savior, has the forgiveness of sins, reconciliation with God and eternal life.
- Jesus returns a second time to send for the Church to resurrect all men, and to judge the living and the dead
- What humans, influenced by Satan disobeyed and moved away from God, but is loved by God, and he is called to change their lives and be converted to restore a true relationship with God and just next by the grace of God alone that we receive through faith alone in Jesus Christ and not by the good deeds we can do or have done
- That baptism, ordained by Jesus Christ - meaning, by immersion, death and resurrection-, is the testimony of faith, free commitment to Jesus Christ and His Word, and the passage from death a new spiritual life with God
- In the Holy Spirit, sovereign presence of God who dwells in the believer in Jesus to reveal the truths of Scripture, and to communicate the love, wisdom and peace
- That the baptism in the Holy Spirit is a promise to Christians of all ages.
- In the spiritual gifts (or charisms) mentioned in the Scriptures, and that the Holy Spirit gives to the Church.
- That the Church is the congregation of believers who keep the faith in Jesus Christ. Jesus is the supreme leader. ... His first mission is to proclaim the gospel worldwide
- What The Last Supper, instituted by Jesus Christ, to be perpetuated in the Church until his coming
- In the resurrection of all humans and the final judgment. Those who believe in Jesus Christ will live forever in the Kingdom of God. For others, they will know the eternal punishment

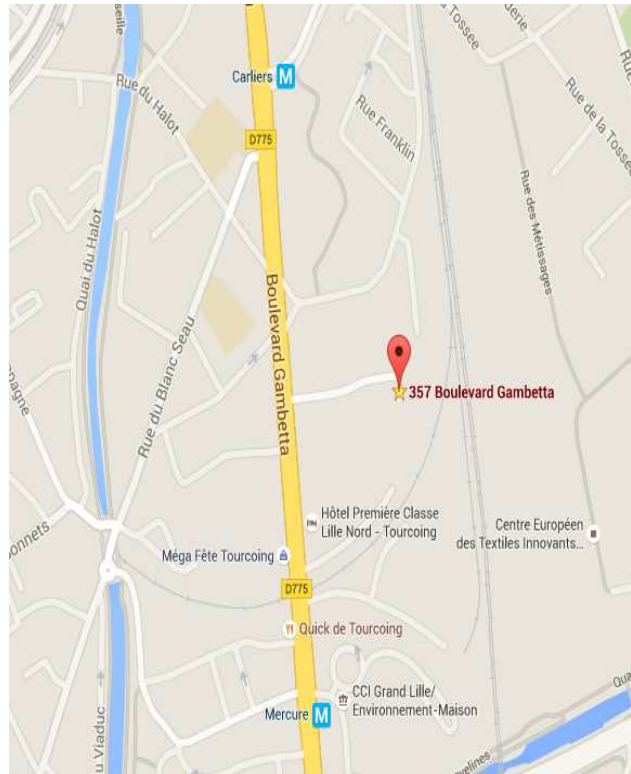

 - John 11:53 "Many of the Jews .. and saw what Jesus did believed in him." **The Christ of wins in my difficult situations will lead many to believe in Him**
 - John 14: 12 "... whoever believes in me will himself the works that I do. He will do even greater ...: **by my faith I can be useful for the kingdom of God**

4. The name: BETHANIA given by prophecy

Bethany is introduced thought John 11 as the city of the friends of Jesus (Mary, Martha, Lazarus, a family who loved Jesus and Jesus loved and taught). The small town next to the large (Jerusalem) who lives greater things with Jesus, the victory of life over death.

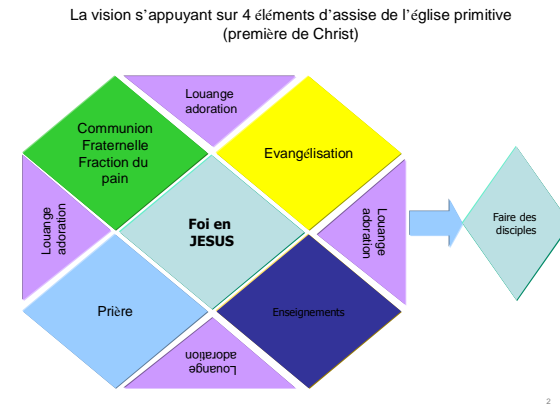
CEP BETHANIA mean that in mind and not literally the assembly of men, women and children:

- His return hope and beware of sin

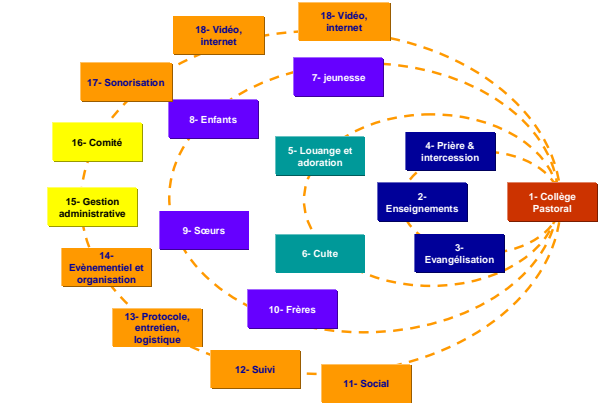
5. The organization and main areas of activity

6. Register or becoming a member

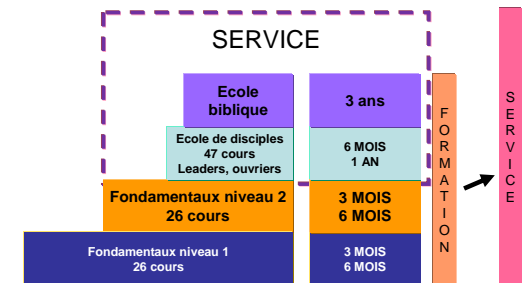
It is led by God confirmed by a personal desire to conform to biblical living arrangements present.
